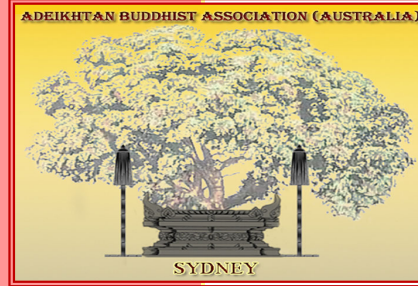

PROJECT MASTERPLAN



The project is called Ananta Theikdi Su-Htoo-Pan Buddha Statue Project and is designed to build one of the largest Buddha statue in the Pacific region. The statue will take at least four years to build extending from 2010 to 2014. The project timetable is as follows: -

2009 : To establish a registered association and company, prepare the Master Plan blue print and presentation. The land selection at Goulburn area and launch the World Wide Web site.

2010: To lay foundation for the Buddha Statue and start the Statue construction.

2014 : To complete Buddha statue including Palin (Throne) and Yin Pyin (platform).

2016 : To commence construction of other religious buildings (Sima Hall, Dhamma Halls ,Monastery etc.) and have land scaping completed.

2018 : To commence construction of meditation village .

The project Master Plan blue print will be prepared by Myanmar Architects and Engineers . The detailed design will be finalised to Australian standard by the licenced engineers from Australia to get approval for construction.

The construction of the Buddhist Museum (indoor as well as out door) will be part of the project.

SAYADAW'S PROJECTS



Funded by the donations received world wide, Sayadaw has built the following famous pagodas and religious buildings all over Myanmar:

- 3,716 sq.m wide Mahajeyyasidhi Adeikhtan Sima hall at Sittwe (A\$ 3 millions - Kyat 20,000 lakhs).

- 11 meter high Chan Tha Gyi standing Buddha statue at Palet Wa (A\$ 150,000 - Kyat 1,000 lakhs).

- 21 meter high Law-Ka -Htate-Pan sitting Buddha statue at Pauk Taw (A\$ 460,000 - Kyat 3,000 lakhs).

- Lawka Marazine Sima hall at Pong Nar Kyun (A\$ 460,000 - Kyat 3,000 lakhs).

- 22 meter high Mahar Kangyi Shin sitting Buddha statue at Kyauk Thaw (A\$ 460,000 - Kyat 3,000 lakhs).

- 21 meter high Aung Supan standing Buddha statue at Pong Nar Kyun (A\$ 150,000 - Kyat 1,000 lakhs).

38 meter high Mahar Kyein Thitsar Shin sitting Buddha statue at North Okalapa (A\$ 2.5 million - Kyat 1,600 lakhs). The project is targeted to complete in end of 2010.

- 55 meter high Ananta Theikdi Su-Htoo-Pan sitting Buddha statue in Sydney is the first overseas project by Sayadaw.
